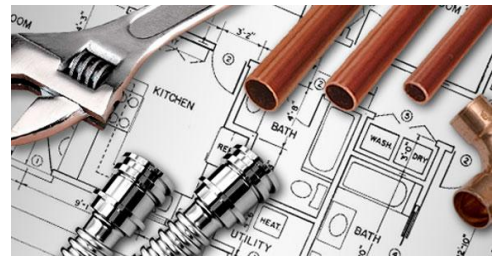
Check out the subjects the plumbing industry recommends to get you started.

Years 9 and 10

Mandatory subjects:

- Mathematics
- Science
