7 EASY STEPS ON HOW TO BECOME AN APPRENTICE PLUMBER

1. Complete an application form and attach it to the front of your resume. Please refer to the application form for a list of supporting documents you will be required to submit with your application. Your resume must be similar to our guide, to progress to step 2.

2. If your application meets the minimum requirements, you will be invited to sit an aptitude test at a Year 10 level in Maths and English. NO calculators are allowed.
3. Applicants achieving the minimum benchmark score will then be invited to attend an interview with MPAL Staff. On completion of the interview you will be invited to undertake a Harrison Motivation Assessment.
4. Candidates may be required to attend a %Pre-Vocational+ or the MPA NSW %Bridging the gap+course to demonstrate their ability to succeed as an apprentice.
5. Attend a medical examination.
6. Attend a final interview with the Operations Manager/General Manager.
7. Prior to commencing work, you will be required to complete an induction workshop and sign up to your apprenticeship.
